Rules: The National Rifle Association's Smallbore Rifle Rules, January 2014 Revision; & The National Rifle Association's International Rifle Rules April 2013 Revision (Rifle definitions) will govern these events.

Competition Requirements : open to all preregistered competitors, eligible to compete in the World Police & Fire Games. Competitors may complete their registration via the Official website of the 2015 World Police & Fire Games: <http://fairfax2015.com>

Entry Deadline: April 30th, 2015. Post deadline entries will not be accepted.

Firing Starts: 9:00AM EST

Classification System: WPFMG Classifications will be used. Competitors from past Games will automatically have their classification entered into the computerized scoring system for the Individual Match and the English Prone Match (separately). A competitor without an established WPFMG classification may use their official national classification card or Score Record Book to receive an “Assigned Classification” for the specific event. Please refer to the following table for Classification criteria. Competitors without established WPFMG Classifications will be classified on the basis of their score for the Individual Match, and then be placed into the appropriate class for the determination of medals for the Individual Event, Team Event and the English Prone Match.

Classification	Average
Master	92.00 and above
Expert	87.00 to 91.99
Sharpshooter	80.00 to 86.99
Marksman	Below 80.00

Awards: Gold, Silver, & Bronze Medals will be awarded for Individual & Team Event Winners in each Classification. The Awards ceremony will commence upon finalization of the scores, at the conclusion of the match for each day in the Clubhouse.

Match Schedule & Conditions:

Relays: If 30 or fewer competitors are registered by the deadline, the match will proceed as a single relay match. If 31 or more competitors are registered by the deadline, the match will proceed as a two relay match.

Teams: 4-Person Team scores will consist of the aggregate of the Individual Event Scores from all competitors for each team. **Competitors must be entered in the Individual Event to be eligible for participation on a team.**

Squadding: Competitors will be squadded and assigned firing points on the scheduled Practice Day (July 1st, 2015). Firing points will be assigned by draw.

Course of fire: NRA Outdoor Metric Position 3 X 20, fired on the **NRA A-51 Target (50 Meter ISSF Target, reduced for 50 Yards), and the appropriate target backer.** 5 shots on each record bull. Sighter shots are unlimited in number, and a competitor may return to the sighter bullseye at any time, however no additional time is allowed for sighter shots. **All fouling/sighting shots MUST impact the berm behind the 50 Yard line.**

Equipment:

Standards for competitors rifles are governed by the NRA International Rifle Rules April 2013 Revision:

Sport Rifle: As defined by NRA Rule 3.2

Free Rifle: As defined by NRA Rule 3.1

All Rifles will be single loading, and use metallic sights as defined by NRA Rule 3.7 (a)(1). Corrective lenses may be worn by the shooter. The use of rifle scopes is prohibited.

Per **The Official Entry Book**, competitors will be limited to entering one division:

Division	Weight Limit	Sights
Sport Rifle	6.5 KG	Metallic Only
Free Rifle	8.0 KG	Metallic Only

Ammunition Restrictions: .22 Short, .22 Long, .22 Long Rifle which conforms to NRA Rule 3.17 regarding ammunition.

Other Equipment: Shooting coats, pants, shoes, spotting scopes, stands, etc. which meet the current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules, January 2014 Revision are allowed. Targets, Target Backers, Target Frames, and Target hanging clips will be provided.

Safety Equipment: The Fairfax Rod & Gun Club requires that all persons present on any firing line at the facility wear proper eye & ear protection. Prescription eyeglasses, and frame & lens combinations designed for sports shooting will meet this requirement, as do dedicated shooting/safety eyewear. An **Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required** to ensure that the firearms chamber is “clear”. All competitors **MUST** utilize common safe firearms handling techniques.

Inclement Weather Policy: Rain or Shine. The range is a covered, 30 position firing point.

Lunch: There is an independently operated canteen located at the Club. Competitors may elect to purchase a boxed lunch (sandwich, soda, potato chips) from the the canteen in the morning (the canteen will provide the order form), and have it delivered to the range near the lunch time hour. **The canteen is a cash only operation.**

Range Familiarization: The date for range familiarization for all competitors is July 1st, 2015 from 9:00AM - 3:00PM EST.

Competitors will be given a 1 hour range familiarization period to fire their rifles, and finalize any equipment changes. All safety rules will be followed. **No firing will be allowed after 3:00PM EST.**

Rules: The National Rifle Association's Smallbore Rifle Rules, January 2014 Revision; & The National Rifle Association's International Rifle Rules April 2013 Revision (Rifle definitions) will govern these events.

Classification System: WPFGB Classifications will be used. Competitors from past Games will automatically have their classification entered into the computerized scoring system for the Individual Match and the English Prone Match (separately). Competitors without established WPFGB Classifications will be classified on the basis of their score for the Individual Match, and then be placed into the appropriate class for the determination of medals for the Individual Event, Team Event and the English Prone Match.

Sharpshooter	92.50 to 94.49
Marksman	92.49 & below

Awards: Gold, Silver, & Bronze Medals will be awarded for Individual & Team Event Winners in each Classification. The Awards ceremony will commence upon finalization of the scores, at the conclusion of the match for each day in the Clubhouse.

Match Schedule & Conditions:

Relays: If 30 or fewer competitors are registered by the deadline, the match will proceed as a single relay match. If 31 or more competitors are registered by the deadline, the match will proceed as a two relay match.

Teams: 4-Person Team scores will consist of the aggregate of the Individual Event Scores from all competitors for each team. **Competitors must be entered in the Individual Event to be eligible for participation on a team.**

Squadding: Competitors will be squadded and assigned firing points on the scheduled Practice Day (July 1st, 2015). Firing points will be assigned by draw.

Course of fire: English Match 60 shots prone, fired on the **NRA A-51 Target (50 Meter ISSF Target, reduced for 50 Yards), and the appropriate target backer.** 5 shots on each record bull. Sighter shots are unlimited in number, and a competitor may return to the sighter bullseye at any time, however no additional time is allotted for sighter shots. **All fouling/sighting shots MUST impact the berm behind the 50 Yard line.**

Aggregate	60	85 Minutes per Relay*

***If all competitors of a relay finish prior to the time allotted for the stage, then that stage may be ended upon election of the majority of the competitors.**

Equipment:

Standards for competitors rifles are governed by the NRA International Rifle Rules April 2013 Revision:

Sport Rifle: As defined by NRA Rule 3.2

Free Rifle: As defined by NRA Rule 3.1

All Rifles will be single loading, and use metallic sights as defined by NRA Rule 3.7 (a)(1). Corrective lenses may be worn by the shooter. The use of rifle scopes is prohibited.

Per **The Official Entry Book**, competitors will be limited to entering one division:

Sport Rifle	6.5 KG	Metallic Only
Free Rifle	8.0 KG	Metallic Only

Ammunition Restrictions: .22 Short, .22 Long, .22 Long Rifle which conforms to NRA Rule 3.17 regarding ammunition.

Other Equipment: Shooting coats, pants, shoes, spotting scopes, stands, etc. which meet the current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules, January 2014 Revision are allowed. Targets, Target Backers, Target Frames, and Target hanging clips will be provided.

Safety Equipment: The Fairfax Rod & Gun Club requires that all persons present on any firing line at the facility wear proper eye & ear protection. Prescription eyeglasses, and frame & lens combinations designed for sports shooting will meet this requirement, as do dedicated shooting/safety eyewear. An **Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required** to ensure that the firearms chamber is “clear”. All competitors **MUST** utilize common safe firearms handling techniques.

Inclement Weather Policy: Rain or Shine. The range is a covered, 30 position firing point.
